- **Section 1:** The opening paragraph of Paragraph C. of Section 170-64 (Storage and use of recreational vehicles) of Article VI (Supplementary District Regulations) of the Zoning Law of the Town of South Bristol is hereby repealed and a new opening paragraph is hereby inserted in its place to read as follows:
  - C. Use: Owners of a vacant lot located in the R-1 (One-Acre Residential) Zoning District, the R-3 (Three-Acre Residential) Zoning District, the R-5 (Five-Acre Residential) Zoning District, the NC (Neighborhood Commercial) Zoning District, the C-1 (Light Commercial) Zoning District or the C-2 (Commercial) Zoning District in the Town South Bristol may occupy and use a maximum of one (1) recreational vehicle on their vacant lot provided that:
- Section 2: If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been ordered.
- Section 3: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
